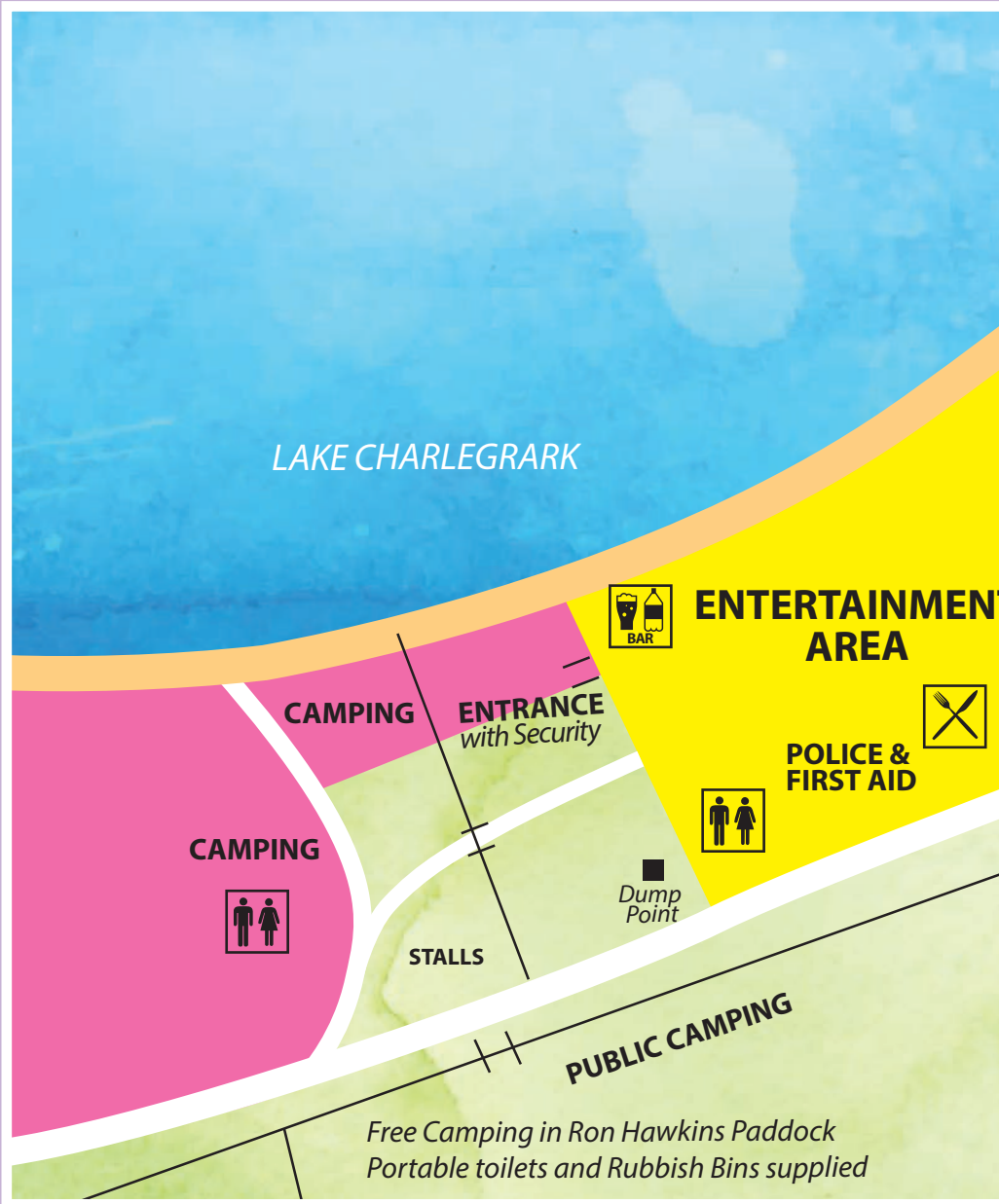

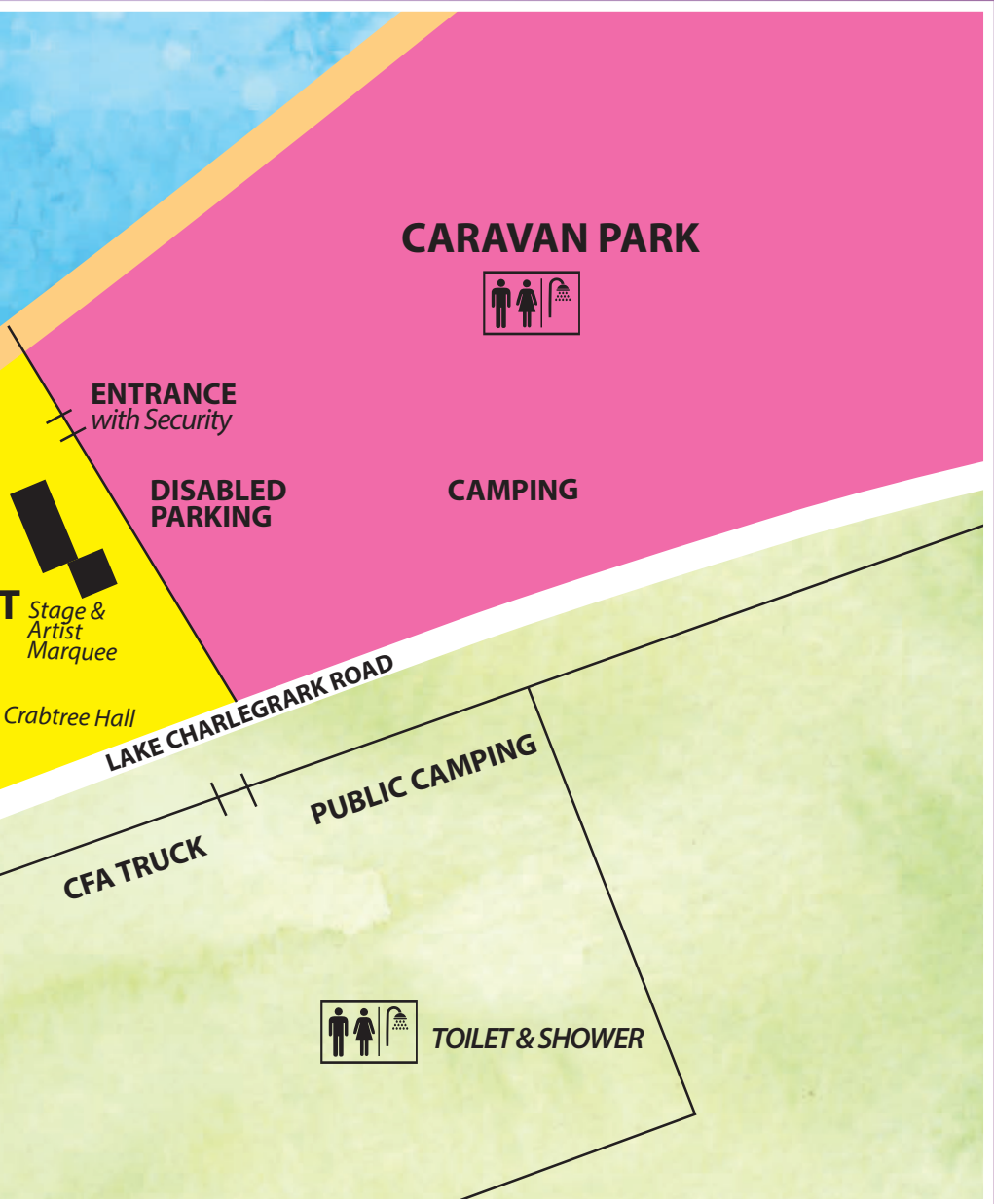

Kasey Chambers

Kasey Chambers was born 4 June 1976, is an Australian country singer-songwriter and musician born in Mount Gambier. She is the daughter of fellow musicians, Diane and Bill Chambers, and the younger sister of musician and producer, Nash Chambers. All four were members of family country music group in Dead Ringer Band, in Bowral, New South Wales, from 1992 to 1998, with Chambers starting her solo career thereafter. Five of her twelve studio albums have reached No. 1 on the ARIA Albums Chart. In November 2018 she was inducted into the ARIA Hall of Fame and has won an additional fourteen ARIA Music Awards with nine for Best Country Album.



Jayne Denham

Jayne Denham is an Australian country singer-songwriter. In 2008, Denham won the Australian Independent Country Music Award for Best Rising Star.(1) Denham has achieved 6 Top 10 songs in the National Country Charts and has received 2 CMAA Golden Guitar Award Nominations.(1) Denham has scored 4 #1 smash hits in Australia, 6 Top 10 songs in the National Country Charts, 12 Top 30 videos, and 6 Country Music Channel (CMC) nominations.



**The Steve
Bartel Band**

Playing a heady mix of foot stomping covers and original music they will keep you dancing with soaring ballads and kicking rock. TSBB has gained a solid reputation as South Australia's premier Country Music, Dance, Party and Show Band. The members of TSBB are no strangers to the performing world, with over 75 years combined experience. This includes playing in numerous bands and session work to laidback duos. The chemistry that has evolved from these guys coming together is amazing. With the release of their very successful debut album 'Time Will Tell', TSBB received critical acclaim from Country radio stations around Australia. Following on from the 'Time Will Tell' album, their single, 'So Go On', released in late 2016 and peaked at Number 3 on the Tasmanian Independent Top 30 Charts. The Band has had some great success with Nigel Jones and Tyga Fm's Tasmanian Independent Country Music Top 30 Charts.



Bill Chambers

Bill Chambers was born in Southend, South Australia and married Diane at age 20. Together they had two children, Nash in 1974 and Kasey in 1976. Shortly after the birth of Kasey in 1976, Chambers moved his family to central Australia's Nullarbor Plain and home schooled Nash and Kasey, and taught them American folk as well as Australian country artists. In 1986, Bill moved the family to Southend, located on the southern coast of Australia, and began playing as a band at local public houses.

As a family quartet, billed under Bill's name, they released Sea Eagle in 1987 and Kindred Spirit in 1991, before changing their name to Dead Ringer Band.

In 2002 Chambers released a solo album called Sleeping with the Blues, which was nominated for ARIA Award for Best Country Album at the ARIA Music Awards of 2003.



Sandra Humphries

Known as "The Real Deal", few can bring that true country feel to a song quite like South Australian singer-songwriter Sandra Humphries. Once she opens her mouth on stage, Sandra's country roots are more than evident in her faultless delivery - you know she's felt that emotion and survived it.

2017 saw Sandra release her 6th studio album, "Walk in Circles", recorded with Stuart French, this much anticipated release features a mixture of original material, as well as songs that Sandra says she feels has shaped her career, and showcases her ability to take a story and make it her own.



Danny Stain

Chart topping Australian artist Danny Stain, brings you all the hit songs from 1950 to today! His unique guitar style and classic vocals, have been entertaining crowds for more than a decade, headlining cruise ships, theatre shows, festivals and pubs around the world. Danny Stain has huge song list that contains hits from Country, Blues, Rock n Roll and Top 40. This way Danny can ensure he has the right songs for the audience no matter the situation. Danny works with some of Melbourne's best cover and original bands!

Brett Gray

Brett Gray is an emerging acoustic rock/alternative country music artist. If you haven't heard his name yet, you're about to! Stemming from outstanding Adelaide band Eleven Days, the front man / singer / songwriter / guitarist embarked on his solo career in 2021 with the release of his debut album, Eleven Days and Then Some. The ten-track album is described as a mix of rolling ballads, foot stomping bar room dance floor fillers, anthemic peaks, and heartfelt songs of history and love lost. With a supporting band of superb Adelaide musicians, Brett is starting to appear at music festivals around Australia. He impresses audiences with catchy melodies, roaring solos, and thought-provoking lyrics. Brett is an entertainer not to be missed!



Graeme Hugo

Graeme began his music career in the Country Music Industry back in 1972 at the age of 18.

During his 41 year career, Graeme has toured nationally with many high profile Country Music Artists, becoming good friends with many of them. He continues to help amateur artists gain experience within the industry, with some going on to win Star Maker or get into the top 20. Graeme believes in giving opportunities to young up and coming artists, keeping the future of Country Music vibrant.

Being a giving person Graeme raises money for the Royal Flying Doctor Service and various children's charities including 'Kids with Cancer'.

Graeme is also continuing to be involved in helping committees in various areas set up Country Music Festivals and in some cases is the entertainment officer, committee member or stage manager of the festivals.



Rodney Vincent

Rodney's show and standing in the Australian entertainment scene is no accident. It is the result of a long, hard apprenticeship which he says 'started a while ago'. From his first engagement playing guitar in an old time dance band at his local hall, to New Faces where he got his first big break, Rodney has survived the highs and the lows of the industry.

Rodney Vincent's reputation for being a genuine all round entertainer has been exemplified in recent years by the fact that he has a terrific following. This loyal following extends from small shows in community halls to any of the national 'Big Time' venues, clubs and theatres. Rodney has served his apprenticeship, he is now an entertainer in his own right.



Heartland

Heartland is headed by Kevin Bergen, who has established a reputation as one of South Australia's most sought after musicians.

His versatility provides Heartland with the unique ability to showcase a variety of lead instruments. He has played in a number of bands such as Both Barrels, Buckshot and is a regular participant in The South Australian Council Of Country Music Showcase band.
